



## Instructions on How to Inform USCIS of your Asylum Case

### 1 Mail these 2 items to the address below:

- A copy of the **first three pages** of your completed form I-589.
- A copy of the court's instructions.

### 2 After USCIS receives your packet, they will send you the following by mail:

- **A receipt** indicating that they received your packet; and
- **A biometrics appointment notice** for you and every beneficiary included in your application. The notice will include the time, date and location of your appointment.

\*\*\* If you don't receive the notice in 3 weeks \*\*\*  
you can call **1-800-375-5283**.

### 3 Lastly, you (and your beneficiaries) should:

- **Attend** the biometrics appointment. Make sure to take the appointment notice and a form of identification (for example, a passport) to the appointment. It is also important to obtain a document confirming your attendance before you leave the office; and
- **Conserve** your confirmation as proof that attending your appointment and take it with you to your future court hearings.

**NOTE:** If you don't follow through with these instructions this could result in a delay in the decision of your application or your application could be considered abandoned by the court.
